## Updates:

- 1) Constructability Assessment Report Rob McMahon
  - a. Refined excess excavation material numbers (neat line):
    - 1. 2009- 900,000 CY
    - 2. 17.1 895,000 CY
    - 3. 17.2 815,000 CY
  - b. Swell is estimated to be 20-35% according to AGEC, with the opportunity to reduce this further through the excavation and placement process
  - c. There is ample placement zone capacity of 1,245,000 CY which accommodates a 52% swell factor for the 17.2 excess excavation material
  - d. Utilities
  - e. Hydrology report
  - f. AGEC soils report

- a. Excavation Rob McMahon
  - i. Approximately 450,000 CY
  - ii. Additional excavation quantities anticipated
- b. Size and height David Eldredge
  - i. Missing elements
    - 1. fire protection plan
    - 2. acceptable Creole ski trail
  - ii. Refinements to height needed
    - 1. certain roof heights exceed allowable
    - 2. insufficient floor to floor heights
  - iii.Gross area and building heights of Woodruff and CUP are approximately equal, even without adjusting for the lost floor area resulting from the City Council Approval (decrease in height)

- 4) Affordable/employee housing email sent to Housing Authority Pat Sweeney
  - a. Approximately 7000 SF onsite plus fees in lieu of for the requirement balance, or,
  - b. if desired, all located onsite with additional floors to be added to existing footprints in order to maintain approved UEs

- 5) Treasure Hill open space disturbance Pat Sweeney
  - a. To date, approximately 41 acres on Treasure Hill has been disturbed and/or graded, SOME OF THESE AREAS OVERLAPPING
  - b. Town Lift and ski trails account for approximately 17 acres
  - c. The Master Plan single family homes account for approximately 15 acres
  - d. City water lines account for over 3 acres
  - e. Other items include roads, power lines, and mining activities
  - f. Approximately 41 acres will be disturbed by the Treasure Project, of this approximately 32 acres will become new ski terrain and the remaining non-skiing project area will be approximately 10 acres

- g. Multiple adjacent land owners have been granted use of the open space over the past 30 years to facilitate construction, fire egress and ski access to their properties
- h. The Master Plan open space has been graded in multiple locations with City building permits in place since its approval
- i. The ROS zoning and underlying agreements allow this
