
PC - SLC Connect Brochure Users Guide




The PC - SLC *Connect* will service markets in Summit County and Salt Lake City during peak commute times.

Routing information is in order across the page and should be read from left to right. Bus departure times are below each destination and also read from left to right.

There are two Peak AM runs and two Peak PM runs for each section of the route. Please notice that some stops may have partial service. For those stops there will be a dotted line in place of a departure time.

Determine your timepoint based on when you want to leave or when you want to arrive. Read across for your destination and down for your time and direction of travel. A route map is provided to help you relate to the timepoints shown.



Fares


Exact Fare is required. Fares are subject to change. The cost to ride is \$5.50 for a one-way trip. Three-day or 30-day passes are also available. UTA Passes including Eco, Ed and Transfer slips are not accepted.

User instructions along with contact and fare information is located next to the routing information.
