WHAT IS DIAL-A-RIDE?
General public passengers with ride reservations will be picked up or dropped off along the route and at the bus stops shown on the back page of this guide. Passengers wishing to travel to other areas in Park City Transit's service area, including Snyderville Basin, may transfer to other routes (typically at the Old Town Transit Center).

WHAT ARE THE HOURS OF OPERATION?
This free service is in operation seven days a week from 8:00 AM to 11:00 PM in the winter months, and 8:00 AM to 9:00 PM the remainder of the year.

MAY I SCHEDULE RECURRING TRIPS?
Yes, "standing orders" of up to 30 days may be established. (For example, a school group that has reserved ice time, a practice field after school on certain days, or a medical appointment.)

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION
ADA certified passengers may be picked up or dropped off anywhere within Park City limits. A penalty may be imposed if a person demonstrates a pattern of not being at a stop at a scheduled time - "no shows." As a courtesy to others, please cancel your ride when your plans change. The purpose of this service is to provide rides between Park City and the Quinn's Junction Recreation Complex (including the National Ability Center), People's Health Clinic and Park City Medical Center. Ride reservations between in-town bus stops will not be provided.

HOW DO I MAKE A RIDE RESERVATION?
Requests for a ride must be made a *minimum of two hours in advance* by calling 435-640-7819. You will be asked to provide your name, phone number, bus stop (numbers 1-7), time you want a ride, and number of passengers. All rides are on a space- and time-available basis, so the more advance notice you are able to provide, the better the chance of accommodating your request. Drivers may try to combine ride requests with previously made reservations to accommodate the most passengers possible, so you may be asked to adjust your pick-up time.

AFTER I SCHEDULE A RIDE, THEN WHAT?
The bus driver will make every effort to arrive at the bus stop at the scheduled time. However, the bus will be considered "on-time" if it arrives 10 minutes before or 10 minutes after the scheduled time. As a courtesy to other riders, the bus cannot wait at the stop for more than 5 minutes. We suggest that you arrive at the stop 10 minutes early.

- 7 PARK CITY MEDICAL CENTER


Dial-A-Ride is a Reservation/Response based service. The inside of the Dial-A-Ride brochure contains service information, policies, scheduling instructions and additional information pertaining to the service.

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On the back cover of the Dial-A-Ride brochure is a map of the service.

Each bus stop is assigned a specific destination and numbered.

Along with the map is a numbered list displaying the Dial-A-Ride service stops in order.

Each bus stop is numbered and corresponds with a stop listed on the map.

The Dial-A-Ride telephone number is provided on each bus stop.
