

Effective: October 16, 2019

Purpose

Define a safe process for allowing dogs on the bus in accordance with State and Federal guidelines. Park City Transit will regulate when dogs shall be allowed on a conditional basis and at the discretion of the Transportation Manager or designee.

The initial, one day pilot program will take place on Halloween, October 31, 2019.

Policy

Service animals and well-behaved dogs are welcome. Only one dog per owner are allowed on the bus. Owners must clean up after their pet.

Dogs must be licensed and current on vaccinations . Dog owners must remain with their dog at all times.

Dogs must remain on a leash at all times and under control. A maximum leash length of 6 feet is allowed, if the leash is retractable it should be locked.

Dogs are not allowed to occupy seats or be in the bus aisle; they must remain either on the floor or sit on their owners lap.

Other pets are only permitted on-board the bus if they are kept inside a pet carrier.

In situations where the bus is full, for passenger and pet safety, the decision is left to the driver's discretion to determine the appropriate limit of dogs on the bus.

Dog owners have sole responsibility for their dog. Park City Transit shall not be liable for any injury or damage caused by any dog.

Aggressive dogs are not permitted on the bus. Dogs must be removed from the bus at the first sign of aggression.

Dog owners who fail to comply with the above rules will be instructed to vacate the bus.
