TAKE THE BUS

Take the bus, bike or carpool to avoid and help reduce traffic. Free transit will be provided from the high school and resort lots to the Main Street/Old Town Area. The City's <u>Electric Xpress</u> & <u>Kamas</u> Service are also running. On the Fourth of July, there will be a bus lane on Deer Valley Drive to expedite transit.

FREE AND PAID PARKING

Parking is Free at the Park City High School, Canyons, Park City Base and Deer Valley Resort with free transit to Main Street. Limited Parking for \$20 cash preferred per car is also available in China Bridge Parking Structure with entry from Marsac Avenue Only. There are also private parking garages in Old Town that have varying parking rates.





BIKE AND WALK

Bike Valet is available at City Park in the Mawhinney Lot and Lower Main Street, at 9th Street. Leave your car at home and bike. You can also walk to activities on our trail systems, including the Rail Trail and Poison Creek.



PARADE ROUTE - ROAD & PARKING CLOSURES

The Fourth of July parade begins at 11:00 am at the top of Main Street and will end on Park Avenue North of City Park. Parking will be removed from the parade route beginning at 6:00 am on Wednesday, July 4. Plan ahead and take alternative modes of transportation to avoid delays.



ROAD CLOSURES

Roads will be closed to parking from 6:00 am to 1:00 pm on Wednesday, July 4, including Swede Alley, Main Street, Heber Avenue and Park Avenue. These roads will be closed to traffic from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm.
