## **Park City Transportation Information**



### **Stage 5- (Canyons Village to Snowbird** Resort)

TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURES WILL TAKE PLACE ALONG THE ROUTE IN PARK CITY FOR **APPROXIMATELY 30 MINUTES BETWEEN 12 PM** AND 3PM.

Temporary road closures will impact Kearns/Hwy 248, Bonanza, Deer Valley Drive, Marsac Avenue to Guardsman's Pass.

- All vehicles and transit on race course will be interrupted during temporary closures during this section of the race.
- \*Additional roads in Summit County will be impacted. www.tourofutah.com



#### 1:00 PM AND ON THE RETURN OF THE RACE **BETWEEN 3:30 AND 5:00 PM**

- 1. Free parking with free transit is available from Park City High School, Canyons Cabriolet Lot or Park City Base Lot to Main Street.
- 2. Paid Parking available for \$20 with no in and out privileges in China Bridge from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm with access only from Marsac Avenue. It is estimated that there will be no exit or entry to the garage due to the race route from 3:00 to 5:00 p.m. Additional paid parking is available at private parking garages in Park City.
- **3.** Blue Permit pass holders can park in North Marsac and Gateway Center. There is no entrance or exit from these lots during the start or finish of the race.
- **4.** Free Bike Valet on Swede Alley at the Galleria Lot.

Race Start (approximately 11:00 am-1:00 pm) The race will start with two ceremonial laps in the Old Town area. Temporary street closures will impact Main Street, Swede Alley, Deer Valley Drive, Heber Avenue, Bonanza and Kearns / HWY 248.

Race Finish (approximately 3:00pm-5:00pm) The final section of the race course will have cyclists race over Guardsman Pass Road from Midway into Park City. Street closures will include: Guardsman Pass Road/SR-224, Marsac Avenue, Empire Canyon, Deer Valley Drive, Main Street, Heber Avenue and Swede Alley.
