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SR-248 TRANSMISSION WATER LINE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Utility Project In progress

CONSTRUCTION DATES

Currently under construction on SR-248, project conclusion anticipated October 2020.

PROJECT DETAILS

Phase I of the SR-248 Transmission Water Line Improvement Project, an integral part of the overall master plan for the treatment of water draining from the Judge and Spiro Tunnels, is nearing completion.

Crews are currently working along the south side of SR-248, from Wyatt Earp Way to Comstock Drive, between 7:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m., Monday-Friday.

Once Phase I is in service, crews will start install toward Bonanza Drive. Crews working on the project will follow strict guidelines to remain in compliance with the Summit County Public Health Order.

PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROJECT

CONSTRUCTION DATES

Throughout Summer 2020.

PROJECT DETAILS

In an effort to maintain an average of 10 years or higher on our roads and to reduce costs in the long term, Park City will continue to maintain the City's investments in its streets, roads and bike paths. Proper pavement management minimizes the need for costly road reconstruction.



- 108,916 square yards of slurry seal.
- 30 tons of crack seal to various city streets and 3 tons of crack seal to bike paths (prolongs pavement life by sealing the surface cracks).
- 6,443 tons of asphalt for pavement overlays.
- 14,228 square yards sealcoat to maintain bike path safety.

Schedule for road and bike path maintenance treatment will be announced throughout the summer.

3KINGS WATER TREATMENT PLANT

Municipal Project In progress

CONSTRUCTION DATES

• The 3KWTP construction is now fully underway. Completion anticipated April 2023.

PROJECT DETAILS

- The pedestrian walkway adjacent to the project site and along the west side of Three Kings Drive installed in May 2020. Construction mitigation efforts are continuous throughout project.
- Excavation and concrete foundation pours for structures ongoing.
- A temporary building for the treatment of drinking water from the Thiriot Spring was installed. This building, located along Three Kings Drive at the northwest corner of the site, will be removed as the 3KWTP work is completed.
- Work within the Golf Course area of play was completed in advance of the course opening.
- Design and scheduling for dredging of the golf course ponds progressing.

- Located between the municipal driving range and 10th fairway, the new building consists of approx. 8,500 sq. ft. of equipment and materials storage, repair and washing facilities, and office space.

Tunnel opened early 2020, the final tunnel construction items consists of minor concrete work, pavement repairs, landscaping and irrigation, grading, snow melt system, lighting and programming.

• 100% net zero design: all lighting and electric snowmelt system offset by solar panels on railings.



- A pedestrian tunnel between PC High School and Cooke Drive replaced the street-level crossing.
- The tunnel helps to alleviate traffic congestion and provide safer access for pedestrians.

SUMMIT BIKE SHARE STATIONS – MULTIPLE LOCATIONS Joint Project In progress Joint Project

CONSTRUCTION DATES

10 stations completed in 2019. Remaining Jeremy Ranch station complete in 2020

PROJECT DETAILS

- Using a federal grant, 11 new stations will be installed within greater Park City. The new stations support 60 new bikes, improving availability and convenience.
- New locations include: North City Park, Deer Valley Resort, Upper Main Street, PC MARC, Basin Recreation Fieldhouse, Summit County Health Department, Willow Creek Park, Silver Springs, Justice Center and Ecker Park & Ride. The Jeremy Ranch Park and Ride location is anticipated 2020.
- The Bike Share Program opened in May for the 2020 season.
