# EMPLOYEE HOMESTAKE LOT PARKING REGISTRATION

Beginning December 15th, Old Town employees can leave their car at the new Homestake Employee Park-and-Ride Lot and take a free shuttle to Old Town. This lot is only a mile from Main Street.



## HOURS OF OPERATION

- Noon to 4:00 am (This tentative schedule will adjust as we collect data on ridership.)
- Shuttle will pick up and drop off from Old Town Transit Center
- 10-minute frequency during peak hours



## SAFETY

The lot is receiving a number of safety upgrades including:

- New lighting and landscaping
- Bus shelter
- New pavement and striping



## ENFORCEMENT

The lot will be monitored to ensure only Old Town employees park there. Enforcement will use license plate-reading technology, so your license plate number will need to be registered in our database.

### HOW TO REGISTER YOUR VEHICLE(S)

- Send an email with your first and last name, license plate number and state, and employer to [homestakeparking@gmail.com](mailto:homestakeparking@gmail.com).
- You must include the name of your Main Street area employer.
- Once we have registered your vehicle(s), you will receive a confirmation email.

## CARPOOL PERMIT PROGRAM

- Established carpool of 2 or more people are eligible.
- The employee carpool permit is available for employees of businesses in the Park City Historic District "South of 12th Street" and allows FREE parking in the China Bridge Parking Structure.
- Permit registration begins November 15, 2017. Applicants must register in person at Public Works, 1053 Iron Horse Drive, Park City, UT 84060.
- Carpools must be established with two or more applicants, meaning that two or more employees must plan to carpool to utilize the permit.
- The carpool permit allows parking at all hours, including after 6:00 pm on Fridays and Saturdays.
- If fraudulent use is detected, carpool permit privilege will be revoked without exception. If a carpool permit is used by a single individual, all permits within the carpool will be deactivated without the ability to renew. Applicants must sign an agreement to adhere to permit rules.

Park City and Summit County offer the "Guaranteed Ride Home" program to commuters who ride the PC/SLC Connect or Kamas Commuter. Registered participants who need transportation in case of an emergency or unforeseen circumstance can be reimbursed for their trip in full (excluding tip).
