

Public Art Advisory Board (PAAB) Vacancies Notice Date: Monday, June 1, 2020

The Mayor and City Council are looking for community members to serve on the Park City Public Art Advisory Board (PAAB) to fulfill four vacant terms. Three of the terms are available for reappointment.

Those interested in applying must have full time residency within the limits of Park City. Board members serve three-year terms, and may serve no more than two consecutive terms. The Board meets on the second Monday of every month at 5:00 p.m. at City Hall in the Marsac Executive Conference Room. Board members are not compensated and serve as representatives of the citizens of Park City.

PAAB makes recommendations to City Council regarding Public Art planning, expenditures and maintains the City's public art inventory. The seven-member board focuses on project identification, requests for proposals, selection process (including reviewing artists' proposals for each project), and making recommendations to City Council.

An interview schedule will be sent out after the application deadline. Appointments are anticipated to be scheduled at the City Council meeting on Thursday, July 9. The selected candidates will begin their term at the July 13th meeting.
