



DEER VALLEY DRIVE CONSTRUCTION OVERVIEW 6/6/13

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Crews will be working on utility improvements. Construction activities are shown below. All travelers, including motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians need to pay attention to the signs and flaggers through the area. Use Mellow Mountain to Aerie Drive as an alternate to avoid the construction area especially between the hours of 4-5 pm.

Construction Activities

TARGET DATE*	WORK PERFORMED	IMPACTS
6/8/13	Water line work	Crews will be working on Saturday from 7 to 6 pm.
6/10/13- 6/14/13	Remove concrete and mill areas of asphalt. Asphalt patching will also take place.	One-Way flagging operations in place
6/7/13- 6/14/13	Storm drain lining at Rossi Hill Intersection	Traffic to and from Rossi Hill will be closed except right turns from Deer Valley Drive EB to Rossi Hill. Use Deer Valley Loop as a detour.
Ongoing	Construct new water line / laterals and place water meters for some residents along corridor.	Access to some properties is necessary to replace the existing water meters. One-way flagging operations in place.

*Dates / Activities subject to change due to weather or equipment / material issues.

Please expect reduced lanes, one way flagging operations, and detours. Up to 5 minute delays expected. Pedestrians and bicyclists are urged to use an alternate route.

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The project will provide the following improvements between the roundabout at Marsac Avenue/Deer Valley Drive to the "Y" at Deer Valley Drive North and Deer Valley Drive South:

- Upgrade utility lines including lining to the storm drain and replacing the distribution water line.
- Improve traffic flow by constructing bus pullouts, adding a turn lane at the intersection of Deer Valley Drive / Deer Valley Drive North as well as updating directional signing and striping throughout the project area.
- Resurface the roadway from the roundabout to Snow Park Lodge. (The area from The "Y" to Snow Park Lodge is an additional project being done by the city. Updates for this project are included for simplicity.)
- Enhance pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure specifically increased lighting through the corridor.
