Universal and Specific Design Guidelines will be reviewed for: Site Design; Primary Structures: Foundations; Exterior Walls; Roofs; Store Fronts; Doors (Not included in Storefronts); Windows (not included in storefronts); Gutters & Downspouts; Historic Balconies/Porticos; Decks, Fire Escapes, and Exterior Staircases; Chimneys and Stovepipes; Architectural Features; Mechanical Equipment, Communications, and Service Areas; Paint & Color; Additions to Primary Structures: Protection of Historic Sites and Structures; Transitional Elements; General Compatibility; Scenario 1: Rooftop Additions; Scenario 2: Rear Additions; Basement Additions; New Storefronts; New Balconies; New Decks; Handrails; Awnings; and Reusing Historic Houses as Commercial Structures. The Board will provide specific amendments to be made to the document if necessary; and make a recommendation to City Council (Council review will be after the entire Guidelines are reviewed by the HPB).
