Summary Recommendation: Conduct a public hearing and approve the attached resolution adopting the 2007 Park City Historic Building Inventory.

Background:

The Land Management Code, Section 15-11-12: Historic Preservation—Determination of Historical Significance specifies that the Planning Department maintain a list of Historically Significant buildings located within Park City. The list of Historically Significant buildings is an important community development resource because Historically Significant buildings:

- are eligible for specific Land Management Code exceptions;
- are eligible for Historic Preservation Board matching grants for restoration; and
- may not be demolished without City approval of a Certificate of Appropriateness for Demolition (CAD) Permit.

The citywide Historic Building Inventory was conducted the City's Historic Preservation Consultant Dina Blaes and Beatrice Lufkin using the criteria set forth in Land Management Code, Section 15-11-12 (A): Determination of Historical Significance—Standards of Review.

Prior to the start of the inventory fieldwork, copies of previously completed surveys were reviewed. Those surveys included the 1979 Park City Main Street Historic District survey, the 1982 citywide survey, and the 1984 and 2000 (update) Residences of Mining Boom Era Park City surveys. Based on the information noted in these surveys, 571 properties were identified as either undeniably or possibly historic sites. The properties were organized by address and served as the basis for the fieldwork. As the fieldwork progressed, properties not recorded in any of the previous surveys were added to the list while others were eliminated due to duplication, demolition, or reporting inaccuracies.

Each property reviewed during the fieldwork phase that met the survey boundary criteria was recorded on a Reconnaissance Survey Form. The form includes present address, estimated date of construction, exterior materials, height, architectural style, building type or plan, original use, and brief comments. As available and/or as needed, the fieldwork was augmented by a additional review of sources including State Historic Preservation (SHPO) survey files, SHPO National Register files, tax photographs, previous survey materials, building permit files, the County Tax Assessor database of property tax information, and

materials held at Park City Historical Society and Museum. These secondary sources are listed in the Research/Information Sources sheets.

At total of 416 buildings/structures are identified as meeting the Land Management Code standards for Historical Significance. The official list of Historically Significant buildings is attached to this report as Exhibit "A". Notice to affected property owners regarding the October 1, 2007 Historic Preservation Board meeting was mailed on September 17, 2007. The list of Historically Significant buildings and individual property assessment sheets were posted on the City website (www.parkcity.org/hbi) on September 17, 2007.

Analysis:

All buildings/structures were valuated for substantial compliance with the standards of review set forth in Land Management Code Section 15-11-12: Determination of Historical Significance—Standards of Review which specifies that:

In determining the Historic Significance of the Property at the hearing, the HPB shall evaluate whether the Building, Structure or Site demonstrates a quality of Significance in local, regional, state or national history, architecture, archaeology, engineering or culture, and integrity of location, design, setting, materials, and workmanship according to the following criteria:

(1) The Building, Structure or Site is associated with events or lives of Persons Significant to our past; and/or

(2) The Building, Structure or Site embodies the distinctive characteristics of a type, period or method of construction or that represent the work of a master; and/or

(3) The architectural or historical value or Significance of the Building, Structure or Site contributes to the Historic value of the Property and surrounding Area; and/or

(4) The Building, Structure or Site is at least fifty (50) years old, or has achieved Significance within the past fifty (50) years if the Property is exceptional importance to the community; and/or

(5) The relation of Historic or architectural features found on the Building, Structure or Site to other such features within the surrounding Area; and/or

(6) Any other factors, including aesthetic, which may be relevant to the historical or architectural aspects of the Building, Structure or Site.

All buildings/structures which substantially comply with criteria set forth above have been designated Historically Significant and listed on placed on City's Historic Building Inventory which serves as its List of Historically Significant buildings.

Individual property owners may still apply for a hearing on determination of Historical Significance of an individual building on the Historic Building Inventory as provided in the Land Management Code at any time for review by the Historic Preservation Board (provided that the property has not previously had a formal Determination of Significance hearing before the Board).

Any Final Action regarding the adoption of the Historic Building Inventory in its entirety may be appealed to the Board of Adjustment within ten (10) calendar days of the Historic Preservation

Board's action pursuant to the Land Management Code, <u>Section 15-1-18: Appeals and</u> <u>Reconsideration Process</u>.

<u>Staff Recommendation</u>: Staff recommends that the Historic Preservation Board conduct a public hearing and approve the attached resolution (Exhibit "B") adopting the 2007 Park City Historic Building Inventory.

HPB Resolution No. 07-01

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2007 PARK CITY HISTORIC BUILDING INVENTORY AS THE OFFICIAL LIST OF SIGNIFICANT BUILDINGS AND SITES IN PARK CITY PURSUANT TO LAND MANAGEMENT CODE SECTION 151-11-12

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Board is charged with the responsibility of maintaining a list of "Historically Significant" buildings and sites; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Board has determined that the buildings and sites listed as either "significant" or "contributing" on the Historic Building Inventory are "significant" for purposes of the provisions of the Land Management Code; and

WHEREAS, the owners of buildings and sites on the 2007 Historic Building Inventory were properly noticed and afforded an opportunity to challenge inclusion of their property on the survey;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Historic Preservation Board of Park City:

SECTION 1. LIST ADOPTED. Buildings and sites listed as "significant" or "contributing" in the 2007 Historic Building Inventory are hereby adopted in their entirety as the official list of "significant" properties pursuant to Land Management Code Section 15-11-12, or any successor provision.

SECTION 2. LIST TO BE FILED WITH THE CITY RECORDER. The current list shall be kept on file and available to the public at the City Recorder's Office. The survey itself may still be kept in the Planning Department so long as it is referenced by the list on file with the City Recorder and made available for public inspection upon request during regular business hours.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
