SPECIAL EVENTS ADVISORY COMMITTEE (SEAC)

The Mayor and City Council are looking for community members to serve on the <u>Special Events</u> <u>Advisory Committee</u> to fulfill two vacant terms that are available for reappointment.

SEAC provides recommendations to the City Council regarding events that will create a diverse and well balanced offering to the local community. SEAC makes recommendations regarding events with regards to citywide carrying capacity threshold and prioritization, city service fee reduction policy, as well as overall event review and performance evaluation.

Those interested in serving on this committee must reside within the city limits of Park City. Members will serve for a three-year term, and may serve no more than two consecutive terms. Committee members are not compensated and serve as representatives of the citizens of Park City.

Meetings are held the third Wednesday of each month, from 12 noon to 2 p.m. at the Park City Library Community Room. The first meeting for those appointed will be held on Wednesday, July 19. Committee members should also expect to participate in 5 to 10 hours of work outside of meetings.
