ROAD & PARKING CLOSURES

Parking and traffic will be removed from Main Street, Swede Alley & Surface Lots, Heber Avenue, and Park Avenue (9th Street to 14th Street) on Monday, September 4 from 6 a.m. to 1 p.m. Traffic will be restricted in the Old Town area throughout the event.



BIKE, BUS, WALK, CARPOOL

Traffic delays are expected throughout the event. Do your part to help reduce single occupant cars and minimize environmental impacts. We highly encourage residents and visitors to bus, bike, walk or carpool to the event. A Bike Valet can be accessed at City Park from Poison Creek Trail behind the Miners Hospital. Free Transit is available throughout Park City to the event. Be respectful - please do not cut through residential neighborhoods. Expect increased security throughout residential areas.



PAID PARKING

Paid parking is available at China Bridge Parking Structure for \$20 CASH only per vehicle. There are several private parking garages throughout Park City that offer paid parking. Free parking is available at Park City High School with free transit to Main Street. If driving to Main Street, allow extra time for travel and to find parking spaces. Parking is expected to fill quickly. To avoid traffic and parking congestion, take the bus, bike, walk or carpool.
