Candidate Qualifications:

1) Candidates must be a United States citizen at time of filing for candidacy.

- 2) Candidates must be at least 18 years of age at the time of the next municipal election.
- 3) Candidates must be a legal resident of the municipality, or a resident of the recent annexed area, for 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election.
- 4) Candidates must be a registered voter of the municipality.

Pursuant to Utah Constitution Article IV, Section 6, any mentally incompetent person, any person convicted of a felony, or any person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in this state until the right to vote or hold elective office is restored as provided by statute.

A candidacy declaration form and packet of election information are available to interested City Council candidates during the candidate filing period. A candidate packet may be taken for review prior to filing for candidacy, or reviewed in office. At the time of filing, the Election Official will meet with the candidate to go over election requirements and information.

VOTER REGISTRATION

Voter registration forms are available in the City Manager's office, 445 Marsac Avenue, Park City (City Hall). Online voter registration is available at www.vote.utah.gov

To register to vote in Utah, you must:

- _ be a citizen of the United States
- _ have resided in Utah at least 30 days immediately before the next election (8/14/11 Primary tentative; 10/9/11 General)
- _ be at least 18 years old on or before the next election
- _ first time voters must include a copy of a valid form of photo identification or proof of residence (or present it at the polls).

Bring a government issued identification card i.e. drivers license, passport. If a new resident to the County, also bring proof of residency. (435) 615-5184.

Registration Deadlines -

The mail-in voter registration form must be postmarked at least 30 days before an election

8/14/11 Primary tentative; 10/9/11 General

- or -

be presented in person to the County Clerk or City Manager's Office at least 15 days before an election to be eligible to vote in that election 8/29/11 Primary tentative; 10/24/11 General.

If a person registers less than 30 days before an election, he/she may only vote on Election Day and not in early voting.

ABSENTEE VOTING

Absentee voting applications are available for any registered voter in the City Manager's office, 445 Marsac Avenue, Park City (City Hall). Please bring the mailing address of where you will need your ballot to be mailed. (435) 615-5184.

<u>Deadline for applying for an absentee ballot</u> – For regular absentee voting, the ballot application must be received no later than the <u>Friday before the election</u>. (9/9/11 Primary Tentative; 11/4/11 General)

<u>Deadline for overseas voters</u> – The election official should receive the application no later than <u>20 days before the election</u>. (8/24/11 Primary Tentative; 10/19/11 General)

<u>Deadline for returning an absentee ballot</u> – The ballot is only valid if it is clearly postmarked before (not on) Election Day, and received in the election official's office before noon on the day of the official canvass.
