

Dining Deck ProgramA Step-By-Step Guide



Installing a dining deck this spring and summer? Dining deck construction may not begin until the steps below are complete:



Date of Installation

Email your preferred construction date by March 15 to <u>jenny.diersen@parkcity.org</u> and <u>stephanie.valdez@parkcity.org</u>. April 28 is the earliest construction start date. This date will be reflected in your lease. If you are a new to this program, you will also need to go through the Outdoor Dining Conditional Use Permit process. New deck? Leases

The City will provide a draft lease for your review. The name associated with your lease *MUST* match the name on your Certificate of Insurance (COI), or the lease will be rejected. COI requirements are listed on the lease. All necessary attachments must be emailed to stephanie.valdez@parkcity.org. The lease will be routed via Docusign for electronic signature after it is approved by City Council. Restaurants must notify the City if they intend to rebuild an existing deck.



Building Permit

Liquor Licensing

The City will provide a letter of notification to DABS regarding participating restaurants. Restaurants are individually responsible for coordinating with their specific compliance officer regarding liquor licensing. If you need a local consent letter reach out to the Finance Department (contact information below).



Finance

A Business License Extension is required. The Finance Department will automatically extend your existing license at time of payment. For questions, please reach out to Sadie Hennefer, Business License Specialist, business@parkcity.org | 435-615-5225.



Payments

Payments can be made once you have a finalized and executed lease and a permit number from the Building Department. Partial payments will not be accepted. Payments can be made at the Finance Department M-F 8:00 a.m.-4:30 p.m. (2nd Floor of City Hall, 435-615-5221).



Construction

Once all documentation is complete and payment is received, applicants will receive a final executed lease, permits, and notice to proceed with deck construction. Inspections must be completed before decks can open to the public.
