PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The goal of the SR 224 Corridor Enhancement Plan is to create a vibrant and sustainable corridor that provides for efficient vehicular access north-south within the community, while providing an improved environment for pedestrians, bicyclists, transit users, and the businesses and residences along SR 224. The study area for the corridor enhance plan is along SR 224 from Thaynes Canyon Drive to the Bonanza Drive intersection and includes portions of Park Avenue and Deer Valley Drive.

MEETING FORMAT:

The meeting is in an interactive presentation and public input format. **Between 5:00 – 5:30** the public is invited to view the maps, exhibits and other information related to the current and future travel challenges on SR224 along with potential improvements to enhance automobile, pedestrian, cyclist and transit travel along the corridor. **The city's consultant team will make a formal presentation at 5:30p.** This presentation incorporates keypad polling technology so that members of the public can provide immediate feedback or "vote" on a range of issues and options related to corridor enhancement. Following the formal presentation and keypad polling there will be a question and answer session with city staff and consultants.
