








PLANNING VALUES Bonanza Park and Lower Park Avenue




How strongly do you agree or disagree with the following statements for the Bonanza Park and Lower Park Avenue districts?

 - Invest in transit-onlylanes


Share of respondents asked to classify various transportation issues as "very important" or "somewhat important"...
